**Note:**

1. Play will commence at 9:00 a.m. sharp every morning.
2. **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
3. Participants are permitted to play in no more than TWO singles events.
4. Age Guidelines (ITF Guidelines): to participate in a category, players must not pass the age limit within the 2019 Calendar year. E.g. To play 14 & Under, a player must be 14 or less (cannot turn 15) in 2019.
5. **Players who are 15 minutes late for a match shall be defaulted, unless the referee in his/her discretion, after considering all the relevant circumstances, elects not to declare a default.**
6. The 14/16/18s Boys & Girls Singles Events play best of three tie-break sets from quarter-finals to the finals, Advantage Scoring (No Sudden Death).
7. All doubles events will be two sets and a ten-point tie breaker (No add scoring).
8. The Referee reserves the right to change the scoring format in case of unavoidable weather circumstances (e.g. Full Set to Short Set – 1<sup>st</sup> to 4 Games Tie Break at 3 All and Advantage to Sudden Death and vice versa.)
9. Coaching is prohibited during a match. A point penalty system is in operation and the Referee/ Umpire impose penalties will impose penalties according to that system. This can lead to disqualification of the player: ITF Rules 2009. Rule # 30.
10. ITF ANTI-DOPING RULES for tennis have been adopted by TENNIS JAMAICA. Please visit the ITF Website for more information or visit JADCO.
11. **Please note that Certified Copies of the participant's Birth Certificate or the participant's Passport MUST be presented to the Tournament Office as verification of the Age. Entries may also be submitted by schools, and must be certified by Principal/School stamp.**
